## Organizing Authority

Austrian DN Association is organizing country represented by national secretary.

## Date

Friday 17.1.2020 – Sunday 19.1.2020

Friday 17.1.2020 – check-in from 16:00 – 18:00 at race office

Saturday 18.1.2020 – check-in from 09:00 – 10:00 at race office

Saturday 18.1.2020 – skipper meeting 10:00

Saturday 18.1.2020 – first racing day – first race start at 11:00

Sunday 19.1.2020 – last racing day – last race start will be latest at 15:00

## Venue

According the weather forecast the primary regatta site is Lake Lipno in the Czech Republic, Camping Jestřábí, Černá v Pošumaví, Jestřábí, 38223. Secondary location is best ice in the Czech Republic, Austria or Hungary or around. Final selection of the site will be done according Mitropa Trophy Organizational Rules, article c), excluding the decision time. The final decision will be made latest on Friday, 17.01.2020 at 14:00.

## Eligibility.

All competitors shall be members of their National DN Fleet. In Europe these fleets shall be member of IDNIYRA-EUROPE. All DN ice-yachts shall meet the requirements of Official DN Class Specifications. The international ranking list will be used for fleet assignment.

## Trophy

The MITROPA TROPHY itself is a perpetual trophy.

## Entry, registration

Race office = Camping Jestřábí → 48°44'03.4"N 14°05'52.4"E

Against point g) of Mitropa Trophy Organization Rules no online registration is available for this event! Registration is possible without “late entry” penalty. Entry fee is 20 €, to be paid within registration in cash at regatta check-in.

## Insurance

Each sailor has to provide proof of insurance. The 2020 [insurance-ID](#) can be used for Mitropa Trophy 2020 as well. Sailors who do not have an Insurance-ID have to bring their confirmation of cover to regatta check-in. This confirmation has to follow the [rules](#) as described on IDNIYRA-Homepage.

### **Races, scoring, advertising.**

Races and scoring will be managed according to the Race Management Agreement (RMA), NIA sailing rules and the Sailing Instructions.

The Sailing Instructions may be modified at the Skippers Meeting.

RMA (III) 16. will apply with the amendment that each participant may be obligated to attach advertisement or other information from organisers to the hull.

RMA (III) 17. will apply with the amendment that sponsoring of the event is allowed.

8 races are scheduled. Minimum of 3 races is required to complete the regatta. Every 5 races results one throw-out.
