

Please check in time that you will have a proper TPL-insurance for icesailing. This is not only necessary for the “big events” like WC and EC, but also for sailing during the rest of the season. I guess that every participant of WC and EC will try to get some meters of ice under his runners before travelling there.

For several reasons – the explanation of those would lead much too far here – the “Single Event Insurance” will cost 150,-- € (one hundred and fifty Euro). This insurance is only a “safety kid” to make sure that everybody can have a proper insurance at WC and EC. But it should not be the “easy way” to get a proper insurance.

Once again the items for a proper certificate of insurance:

1. the certificate must be in English language.
2. the liability cover must be at least 500.000,-- €
3. the certificate must clearly show that this insurance covers sailing with iceboats including race events and training races.
4. the certificate must show, that the insurance covers the region of Europe including Baltic Sea and Northern Sea. If you have an insurance "worldwide" these regions are covered of course and it's ok.
5. the certificate must clearly show, that it is valid for the time of the event.
